# MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR AND CITY LIBRARIAN

## MESSAGE DE LA PRÉSIDENTE ET DE LA BIBLIOTHÉCAIRE MUNICIPALE

We would like to take this opportunity to congratulate the members of the OPL Board who have committed to advocating for our library system for the 2011-2014 term. We look forward to building a strong working relationship with our new members and are continuing to strengthen our relationship with our returning members. A complete list of our new Board can be found on page 3.

OPL continues to diversify and strengthen its collection and services through e-resources. To adapt to customers' needs, we are offering downloadable music from Freegal Music, a new iPhone app and software CDs. OPL also launched its first video contest for teens 13 to 18 who were required to create a one-minute video on Youtube about their favourite book in order to participate.

We have wrapped up six of the seven Infrastructure Funding projects. The Alta Vista, Cumberland, Sunnyside, Vanier and Vernon branches have all received major improvements to their spaces, including some retrofitting for accessibility, and Greely moved to a brand new building which is approximately three times the size as the previous branch. We are going to continue developing the capital investment strategy to support the renovations and rehabilitation of our remaining branches over the next decade.

Plans for the new West District Library are currently underway. The OPL Board has approved the site of the Beaverbrook branch as the preferred location for the new library. This new establishment will serve the immediate area of its location as a community branch as well as being a resource for the residents a larger area. Combining state of the art technology with customer-focused service, OPL is aiming to have the new branch ready at the end of 2013. It will have two storeys, instead of the existing single storey and will cover roughly 25,000 to 30,000 square feet.

OPL continues to invest in its Early Literacy spaces. The spaces are designed to be bright, colourful, comfortable and appealing - an area for the kids to explore written language through art, games, toys and interactive activities, and for the parents to learn about pre-literacy skills. These spaces encourage parents to share reading and learning experiences with their children and draw them to the resources the library has to offer, in turn developing children's emergent literacy skills.

On behalf of the OPL Board and employees, we would like to wish all our customers a wonderful summer season and we're looking forward to seeing you all at the branches and online.

Nous aimerions profiter de cette occasion pour féliciter les membres du C.A. de la BPO, qui se sont engagés à défendre les intérêts de notre réseau de bibliothèque au cours du mandat 2011-2014. Nous sommes impatients de créer de solides relations de travail avec nos nouveaux membres et continuerons de renforcer les liens déjà tissés avec les membres réélus. La liste complète des membres de notre nouveau C.A. se trouve à la page 3.

La BPO continue de diversifier et d'enrichir son fonds et ses services grâce aux ressources électroniques. Pour nous adapter aux besoins de nos clients, nous offrons la musique téléchargeable de Freegal Music, une nouvelle application iPhone et des logiciels sur CD. La BPO a en outre lancé son premier concours de vidéos destiné aux ados de 13 à 18 ans, qui pouvaient participer en créant une vidéo d'une minute sur leur livre favori et l'afficher sur Youtube.

Nous avons achevé six des sept projets de financement de l'infrastructure. Les succursales Alta Vista, Cumberland, Sunnyside, Vanier et Vernon ont fait l'objet d'importantes améliorations de leurs espaces, avec notamment des travaux de modernisation permettant une meilleure accessibilité, et un tout nouvel édifice, d'environ trois fois la superficie de l'ancienne succursale, a été construit à Greely. Au cours de la prochaine décennie, nous allons poursuivre notre stratégie d'acquisition d'immobilisation afin de soutenir les travaux de rénovation et de remise en état de nos autres succursales.

Les plans de construction de la nouvelle bibliothèque du secteur Ouest sont en cours d'élaboration. Le C.A. de la BPO a approuvé l'emplacement de la succursale Beaverbrook comme endroit à privilégier pour l'aménagement de cette nouvelle succursale. Cette bibliothèque desservira la clientèle du quartier environnant, en tant que succursale communautaire, et constituera une ressource pour les résidents de tout le secteur. Conjuguant une technologie de pointe avec un service axé sur la clientèle, la BPO souhaite inaugurer cette nouvelle succursale à la fin de 2013. Elle comptera deux niveaux, au lieu de l'édifice de plain-pied actuel, et couvrira une superficie de 25 000 à 30 000 pi<sup>2</sup>.

La BPO continue d'investir dans ses espaces d'alphabétisation précoce. Ces espaces sont destinés à être lumineux, colorés, confortables et attrayants. Ils permettent aux enfants d'explorer l'écriture par le biais des arts, des jeux, des jouets et des activités interactives, et sont l'occasion pour les parents de découvrir les habiletés préalables à l'alphabétisation. Ces espaces encouragent les parents à partager des moments de lecture et d'apprentissage avec leurs enfants et les attirent vers les ressources que la bibliothèque peut leur offrir, contribuant ainsi au développement des capacités de lecture et d'écriture des enfants.

Au nom du C.A. et des employés de la BPO, nous souhaitons à tous nos clients une magnifique saison estivale et c'est avec impatience que nous les attendons dans nos succursales et en ligne.

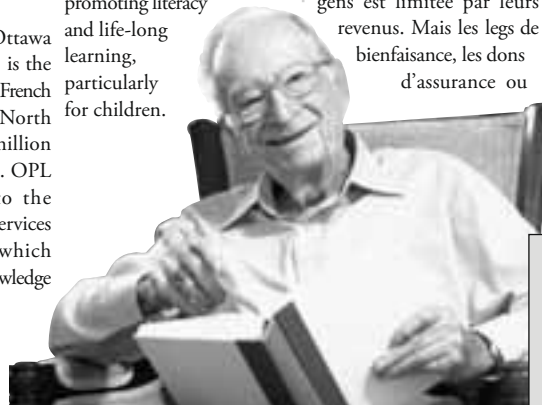

## Diefenbooker Classic – a sprint to success

Runners, walkers and cyclists of all ages took part in the 15<sup>th</sup> annual Diefenbooker Classic on April 30 and raised \$16,977 for the Carp, Constance Bay and Fitzroy Harbour branches.

OPL congratulates and thanks the 498 individuals who participated in this year's event – it always makes for a great healthy family activity.

The event, which was hosted by the OPL Foundation, included a 1 km race for kids 12 years and under, a short "Loonie Loop" race for kids 2 to 6, and for those 13 and over, a 5 km walk, 5 and 10 km running races and 5, 18 and 33 km cycle tours.

## Library renovation brings visitors to new heights

Library customers joined federal, provincial, and municipal representatives on February 19 to celebrate the improvements that were made to the Vanier branch.

MP Royal Galipeau, MPP Madeleine Meilleur, Deputy Mayor Steve Desroches, Councillor Mathieu Fleury, FOPLA President Cindy Streefkerk and Anne-Marie Philippe of Signets Vanier Bookmarks celebrated along with OPL Board Chair Jan Harder and trustees Amelita Armit, Jim Bennett, David Gourlay, Christine Langlois, Danielle Lussier-Meek and Rose Zeidan.

The branch, located in a two-story heritage building, was closed from June 28, 2010 to November 20, 2010 to receive renovations and a retrofit to accommodate an elevator, giving all visitors easy access to second floor resources.

The total project costs were \$750,000. Under the Infrastructure Stimulus Fund, the governments of Canada and Ontario and the City of Ottawa have each contributed \$250,000 toward this project.

The branch was closed to receive improvements on September 7, 2010 and re-opened on January 21, 2011.

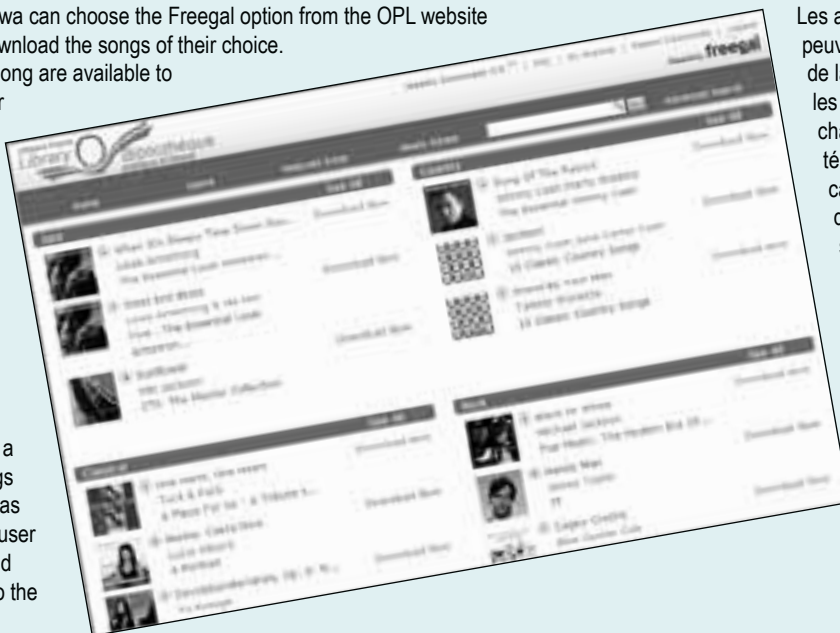
## OPL launches Freegal Music

The Library is now offering downloadable music to its customers. The collection, called Freegal Music, offers listeners free legal access to hundreds of thousands of songs from the Sony Music catalogue.

Music fans across Ottawa can choose the Freegal option from the OPL website and then select and download the songs of their choice.

Sample clips of every song are available to preview before the user actually downloads the title. Customers may browse by artist, title or genre from dozens of categories, including a selection of French music.

Listeners who log in using their Library card number may download a maximum of three songs a week. Once a track has been downloaded, the user owns it. It does not need to be checked back into the Library.



## La BPO lance Freegal Music
