





## Contest rules and regulations

- Deadline: Friday, February 23, 2024, 11:59 pm.
- Submissions will be accepted until February 23, 2024, 11:59 pm.
- Open to all youth residing in Ottawa, ages 9 to 18 (must not yet have completed high school) with a valid OPL library card.
- Submission by outside residents with a non-resident card (family membership) will be accepted.
- There is a limit of one (1) entry per person, per category. The seven categories are: short story, poetry, comic, nouvelle, poésie, bande dessinée and book cover.

#### All submissions must:

- include the title of the piece on each page;
- · be new, original, previously unpublished work;
- be in French or English.

# Please remember:

- Do not put your name on your work.
- · Include one entry form per submission.
- Entries will not be returned.
- All winning entries will be checked for plagiarism. Entries that are plagiarized, previously published or that do not follow guidelines will be disqualified without notice.

#### How to submit in-person:

- Please make two copies of your entry (in color for comics), print and complete this form and drop by to submit your entry.
- Submit your work in person at your local OPL point of service (branch or Bookmobile stop) while an employee is present.
- If you are submitting in French, please use the French version of this form.
- If you are under the age of 16, permission from a parent/guardian is required to participate.

# How to submit online:

• For online submission, please visit <u>BiblioOttawaLibrary.ca/en/awesome-authors</u>, you will need a **valid OPL card**.

### Poems and short stories must be:

- 1000 words or less.
- typed on one side of 8.5"x 11" pages,
- written by a single author.

### Comics must be:

- drawn on one of the OPL templates (in order to offer a better printing quality), and drawn on one side of an 8.5" x 11" page, original **OR** created from computer software using 8.5" x 11" format and following the OPL templates, original drawings,
- one to three pages maximum,
- comics written by two co-authors are accepted.

## Book cover must be:

- drawn or digitally created to fill an 8.5"x 11" page,
- include the book's title: port-pourri 2024,
- · designed by a single illustrator.
